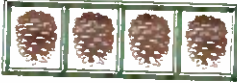

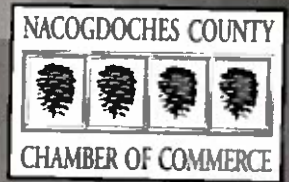

It became a popular movie starring Cary Grant, Raymond Massey, and Peter Lorre. The play centers around the Brewster family: two charming and innocent spinster aunts who have rooms to rent, a brother who believes he is Teddy Roosevelt, another brother who is a psychotic killer, and the third brother, a normal young man who is currently working as a theatre critic. The aunts are populating their cellar with the remains of socially and religiously "acceptable" roomers. Their brother (Teddy Roosevelt) buries the bodies of the men who he believes died of malaria while working on the Panama Canal. The murderous brother who received plastic surgery to hide his identity, unexpectedly arrives with his pal, the plastic surgeon, to further complicate the situation. Jackie Vose and Melissa DeVine will play the aunts. Also among the all-star cast are Kent Johnson, Justin Hughes, David McClary Norton, Trae Norman and Bill Small.
